Donna Fowler asked: 1. if the Council had set any budget for youth activities, the Chairman confirmed that £1000 had been budgeted, 2. whether the Council would maintain the skateboard park, the Chairman responded that the park is inspected weekly by contractors employed by Basingstoke Council and any items needing attention are reported to this Council, 3. if a temporary youth facility could be set up, Cllr Slimin responded that perhaps the creation of a Youth Forum might be able to take forward any future projects and 4. reported that the Hurst Community College is to carry out a project on land adjacent to the skate park to prevent car parking.

Concerns were raised regarding future funding of the facility.
